

Quarterly Curbside Brush Collection Program

The City of Portage is pleased to offer a Quarterly Curbside Brush Collection program. Collection services are provided in the months of **January, April, July** and **October**.

The map at right indicates the week designated for pickup in your neighborhood, starting with the first **full** week of the month. Please have brush at curbside by 7 a.m. on Monday of your designated week. This program includes pickup of **Christmas trees in January** and a collection of **bagged leaves in April**.

How should I prepare my brush?

Branches and brush should be cut into lengths of 4 feet or less, no greater than 3 inches in diameter and stacked in neat piles along the street.

What will not be collected?

Branches or brush in excess of 4 feet in length or 3 inches in diameter, lumber, timbers, ornamental shrubs, yard waste (weeds, flowers, grasses, bark, pine needles, vines, etc.), roots, railroad ties, firewood, brush generated from large tree removal (trunks greater than 4 inches in diameter), building material or tree stumps. The collection equipment cannot handle these items.
