Portage Community Center Holiday Food Basket Program. This list is very specific due to the restrictions on what PCC can accept:

- » Cans of green beans
- » Cans of cream of mushroom soup
- » Cans/boxes of French-fried onions (approx. 6 oz)
- » Cans of corn, carrots, mixed vegetables or peas
- » Boxes of stuffing (approx. 6 oz)
- » Boxes or packet of instant mashed potatoes (approx. 4 oz or larger)
- » Cans of sweet potatoes/yams (approx. 29 oz)
- » Cans of pears, peaches, or fruit cocktail
- » Cans of cranberry sauce
- » Cans of broth
- » Packets of “just add water” turkey gravy mix
- » Boxes of Bisquick Biscuit Mix or similar (20 oz)
- » Boxes of cake mix with frosting or box brownie mix

- » Slipper socks, non-skid
- » Scarves
- » Gloves (one size fits all)
- » Hats (knit type)
- » Pet Food (dog or cat)
